As a prominent woman leader in manufacturing, Kerry defied early setbacks, including expulsion from school, her father's leukaemia diagnosis and her parents' divorce.

Leveraging her ADHD diagnosis at age 12 into a source of creativity later in life, she successfully transformed the family business, diversifying into new markets, doubling its size, and securing many prestigious government contracts valued at over £10 million. Her relentless drive and strategic vision have not only led to business success but also earned her multiple business awards.

Kerry Taylor's journey exemplifies resilience, determination, and the power of overcoming adversity.

The following prizes have particular significance for the College:

The Liz Swift Cup – Liz was a former student of the school who was tragically killed in a traffic accident. Her parents have sponsored this trophy for which we are very grateful. It is given for achievement to a pupil who it is considered has overcome several key difficulties to reach their goals.

The Catherine McAuley Cup – is named after the founder of the Sisters of Mercy – the co-founders of the College and is in recognition of the enormous contribution that the Sisters have made to the College. It is awarded to a student we consider has made a significant contribution to the community – just like the Sisters of Mercy have.

Our **Hull Truck Theatre** sponsored award recognises achievement for Performing Arts. As it plays such an important role in the life of the school, we are very grateful to Hull Truck for helping us to recognise excellence in this area. It is awarded to a student who has made a significant contribution in the College to the Performing Arts.

The Rugby League Cup for outstanding contribution to rugby league. This trophy will be presented to a student who has made an exceptional contribution to the sport.

The Mike Day Cup – this is presented in recognition of the enormous amount of work done by our former Chair of Governors. It is given for excellence in Modern Foreign Languages as he was a teacher within this discipline himself.

The Carole Brown Cup is awarded in memory of a much loved and missed member of staff, Carole Brown. Carole was a Learning Mentor at St Mary's until her death from cancer in 2012. She had spent many hours supporting and building up girls' football in the College, which continues in her legacy, and this trophy recognises her contribution to the school.

The Julie Carr Trophy is in memory of a former teacher at the school who died of cancer in 2009. Julie made a massive difference to the College and all of us in it. She was champion of the underdog and the fighters among us. It is given to a student considered to have made great progress despite overcoming difficult physical challenges.

The 6th Form Student Leadership Award represents our commitment as a College to foster and celebrate the role of students in supporting its leadership. This award will recognise exceptional contributions to leadership from within the student body and the positive impact individuals have had on our community.

The final award is **The Portlaw Cup** presented to a student who has made an outstanding contribution in sport and PE. It was donated by another former Chair of the Governors, Mr Mike Withers. This has become a very prestigious award. Four of the previous award winners have gone on to teach at the school.
