- We were judged to be "Outstanding" in all areas by Ofsted in October 2023
- We were named as the Sunday Times Secondary Comprehensive School of the Year 2024
- 89% of our Year 11 students achieved a grade 4-9 in English in their GCSEs in 2025
- 82% of our Year 11 students achieved a grade 4-9 in maths in their GCSEs in 2025
- 287 Grade 9s achieve in GCSE subjects this year, a huge increase from 137 in 2024.
- Our distinctive and vast enrichment programme is designed to ensure all students have amazing experiences that otherwise they may not be exposed to.
