How is the course assessed in 2021?

Component 3 – Responding to a brief (60 Marks – 18 performance/42 written)

Released in January and rehearsals/external assessments/performance to be completed by 10th May

Activity 1 – Skills log. Up to 800 words focused on:

- The decision behind Concept and style of performance
- Target audience
- Resources that are needed
- How the ideas meet the exam brief
- How the work of practitioners has influenced you
- How you explored ideas practically.

Activity 2 – Idea log. Up to 800 Words focused on

- Your role within the group
- Selected skills and techniques
- How your skills meet the requirements of the brief
- How you developed your skills and techniques
- How the work of practitioners has influenced your development of skills.

Activity 3 – Group Workshop Performance to an Audience (7-15 Minutes)

Activity 4 – Evaluation Report. Up to 800 words focused on how the outcome met the requirements of the brief.

- The development process as an individual and as a group
- Key strengths of the work
- Areas for further development,

What resources are available to me?

Revision pages in preparation for Activity 1/2/4 will be made available. Learners are allowed to create notes to take into each of the written activities. They must follow the exam board guidelines, be approved by your member of staff, and must be retained by the department after use.

What is expected of me?

You must work hard in lessons and communicate with your examination group members. Although you are assessed individually, your teamwork skills are imperative. You must be organised both in lesson time and as part of your home studies too. You will need to keep a weekly log of what activities you have completed in class so that you can complete the note section for your written elements.
