How is the course assessed in 2022?

Paper 1 – Medicine through Time, including the British Sector of the Western Front, 1914-18: injuries, treatments and the trenches (48 marks)

- 1 hour and 15 minutes
- Section A (WWI Medicine, including sources)
- Section B (Medicine through Time)
- Taught in Year 9

Paper 2 – Early Elizabethan England (32 marks)

- 55 mins
- Due to COVID-19 and home learning, students no longer have to study the American West topic so Paper 2 will just include Elizabeth
- Three questions to complete
- Taught in Year 9

Paper 3 - Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918–39 (48 marks, + 4 SPaG)

- 1 hour and 20 minutes
- This paper includes source and interpretation questions
- Taught in Year 10

What resources are available to me?

Revision guides have already been issued to students, including a section explaining what each exam question looks like and how to answer it. Revision sessions take place every Wednesday lunchtime and after school. Staff are always happy to help so you can ask any History teacher a question if you are unsure and can't find your teacher.
