In the last newsletter I reported that Kenya Power had installed electricity poles near the school. On this visit we were able to fully fit out the school with plugs and sockets and connect to the grid. This will open up so many new opportunities for the school. (See below)

In addition, we had twenty new desks built to accommodate our ever increasing pupil numbers.

Funds were also spent on over 100 text books, for the new subjects recently introduced to the education system in Kenya, including agriculture, art, PE and music.

Many pupils arrive early when it is still dark and as it often gets dark by 6pm, some are still at school in the dark evenings.

Having lights will enable pupils to take advantage of those extra hours at school and in fact ensure the school becomes a safer place for everyone.

In addition, electricity will enable us to explore the possibility of connecting the school to the internet and potentially installing computers.

This would have an immeasurable impact on the school enabling us to introduce new ways of bringing teaching to life, thereby transforming our pupils learning.
