## Focus on Ports & Logistics.....

**Ports** have, throughout history, been a place where goods and people arrive or leave the country by sea. **Logistics** is the management, movement & storage of products. It is about getting the right product to the right place, at the right time. It is also about the movement of people by road, rail, sea and air. It includes postal and courier services. Large companies such as supermarkets run their own logistics while other companies outsource all their logistics to specialist companies.

#### **Did you Know?**

- The Ports & Logistics Sector accounts for 7% of the region's workforce, employing around 27,000 people.
- The Humber Ports make up the biggest port complex in the UK;
- Humberside International Airport has England's 4<sup>th</sup> largest heliport. The helicopters make 70,000 passenger journeys to the North Sea each year serving the offshore energy sector
- 10million vehicles, 200,000 pedestrians and 50,000 cyclists cross the Humber Bridge every year

### Will there be opportunities available?

- The skills profile of the maritime sector will change significantly over the coming years. The importance of STEM subjects will increase as jobs become more skilled and data driven in response to new technology.
- Industry roles will be multidisciplinary, potentially requiring the ability to create, operate and maintain autonomous and technological systems.
- The sector is set to continue to grow in the Humber Sub-Region as a result of the investment in the Energy and Renewable Sector
- Employment in the logistics sector is expected to grow by 16% nationally

#### Maritime UK Careers

Responsible for enabling 95% of the UK's global trade, maritime touches every part of our lives. Quite simply, without maritime, half the world would freeze, and half the world would starve.

From working at sea or in a port, to working in the City of London, to cleaning the oceans of plastics or designing a superyacht, maritime is big business. We add more to the economy than both rail and aviation combined. Working in maritime is exciting, rewarding and unlike any other industry.

With the sector expected to double in size to \$3trn by 2030, we need the next generation of innovators and problem solvers to join the industry and help shape the future of the world we live in.

There are lots of different routes into a career in maritime, including a university qualification or an apprenticeship.

## Top tips for creating your CV



#### What is a CV?

A CV, which stands for curriculum vitae, is a document used when applying for jobs. It allows you to summarise your education, skills and experience enabling you to successfully sell your abilities to potential employers.

#### What to include in a CV

**Contact details** - Include your full name, home address, mobile number and email address.

**Profile** - A CV profile is a concise statement that highlights your key attributes and helps you stand out from the crowd. Usually placed at the beginning of the CV it picks out a few relevant achievements and skills, while expressing your career aims. A good CV profile focuses on the sector you're applying to, as your cover letter will be job-specific. Keep CV personal statements short and snappy - 100 words is the perfect length.

**Education** - List and date all previous education, including professional qualifications. Place the most recent first. Include specific modules only where relevant.

**Work experience** - List your experience in reverse date order, making sure that anything you mention is relevant to the job you're applying for. If you have plenty of relevant work experience, this section should come before education.

**Skills and achievements** - This is where you talk about the foreign languages you speak and the IT packages you can competently use. The key skills that you list should be relevant to the job. Don't exaggerate your abilities, as you'll need to back up your claims at interview.

**Interests** - 'Socialising', 'going to the cinema' and 'reading' aren't going to catch a recruiters attention. However, relevant interests can provide a more complete picture of who you are, as well as giving you something to talk about at interview. Examples include writing your own blog if you want to be a journalist, or being part of a drama group if you're looking to get into sales.

**References** - You don't need to provide the names of referees at this stage. You also don't need to say 'references available upon request' as most employers would assume this to be the case.

### CV Top Tips

Employers get lots of CVs to look at and have to decide quickly who they are going to interview. Here are some tips to make your CV stand out for all the right reasons.

When writing your CV remember:

- research the company and the job before you start
- choose a CV style that fits your situation or one that employers in that type of job prefer
- word-process your CV and use clear lettering like Arial, Times New Roman or Calibri, size 11 or bigger - always use the same style throughout
- use headings, bullet points and spacing to break information up to make it easier to read
- keep it to 2 sides of A4
- be clear and to the point
- match the words you use to the keywords in the job description or advert
- get someone else to read it to double check your spelling and grammar
- save a copy, including a final pdf version for emailing
- always send your CV with a <u>cover letter</u>
