Furthermore, there are 6 **optional** activities to complete if you wish all centred around reading and the books we love ©




#### HAVE YOU READ AWAY 10 MINUTES TODAY?

#### BOOK COVER DESIGN CHALLENGE!


"Don't judge a book by it's cover"...or at least that's what we're always told! It's easier said than done though – the cover is the first thing we see and often what draws us to a book in the first place!

Design a cover for a book that you thought could be better!







#### Week 2 Challenge MEET MY FAVOURITE AUTHOR


This week's challenge is to find out a bit more about your favourite author!

If neither of these options are available, OR you can't find an answer, take a guess – where do you think they might be from, how old do you think they might be? Be as creative as you can!








