

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from their committed effort to this summer's GCSE & BTEC grade awarding process, your child will be eagerly anticipating receiving their results. Our policy with early entry examination has always been to hold results until the start of the academic year to ensure pastoral and academic support is available when the students collect their results. As such your child's examination results will not be available during the summer. However, it is important we recognise the importance of these qualifications and the effort our students put into achieving them. As such, we will hold a Year 10 results day on **Thursday 9th September 3-4:30 pm at the bottom of the SM6 building**. This will allow staff from subject departments and the year team to be available so we can ensure a positive start to your child's final academic year of secondary education. Students do not need to be in uniform and we politely request all students take a lateral flow test before coming on site as part of our measures against Covid-19.

You may collect results on behalf of your child if you can present staff with a signed letter from your child stating they are happy for you to retrieve their results. Alternatively, if you and your child are unavailable on that day results will be issued during the school day on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September.

Please note, the results slips are a notification of your child's success and not the certificates they will need to produce for further education or employment. These will be issued in November 2022 after all qualifications have been completed. If you have any further enquiries, please contact the year office in the first instance.
